Who can be a Ferguson Library Summer Teen Volunteer?

Anyone between the ages of 12 and 18 who can volunteer at least five hours during the summer. (You must turn 12 by June 15.)

What does a volunteer do?

- Helps run the children's and teen's summer learning clubs.
- Assists with special projects and activities

When do volunteers work?

From June 15 to the end of the Summer Learning Club. You can set your own schedule to work any hour that the library is open.

Volunteers work no more than a couple of hours a day or a few hours a week so there is lots of time for summer activities.

Why volunteer?

- To help others
- To learn job skills
- To earn community service hours
- To meet other teens and have fun!

How do I become a Summer Teen Volunteer?
